PRINCIPLE PARTS: **amor, amari, amatus sum**

PRESENT STEM **amā-**

FUTURE INDICATIVE

SING.	1	<b>amābor</b> <i>I shall be loved</i>
	2	<b>amāberis (-re)</b> <i>you will be loved</i>
	3	<b>amābitur</b> <i>he will be loved</i>
PLUR.	1	<b>amābimur</b> <i>we shall be loved</i>
	2	<b>amābiminī</b> <i>you will be loved</i>
	3	<b>amābuntur</b> <i>they will be loved</i>

FUTURE PASSIVE IMPERATIVE

SING.	2	<b>amātor</b> <i>you shall be loved</i>
	3	<b>amātor</b> <i>s/he shall be loved</i>
PLUR.	2	-----
	3	<b>amantor</b> <i>they shall be loved</i>

FUTURE PASSIVE INFINITIVE

**amātum iri** *to be about to be loved*

FUTURE PASSIVE PARTICIPLE (GERUNDIVE)

**amandus, -a, -um** *to-be-loved (lovely)*
