Total sale, with tax (κεφάλαιον σὺν ἐπονίο[ις]) of Alcibiades' property.

Sale of property owned by Kephisodoros, a resident alien (μέτοικος) living in Peiraius (Κεφισοδόρο μετοίκο ἐμ Περα[ιεῖ οἰκόντος]). On this fragment, some of the slaves that he owned are listed.

2. This inscription dates to before the Athenians adopted the Ionian alphabet in 403 B.C. Note the spelling changes:

Κεφισοδόρο = Κεφισοδόρου  
μετοίκο = μετοίκου  
Θραῖξ ὁ; Θραῖττα ἢ Thracian  
Σύρος ὁ Syrian  
Κάρ ὁ; Κάρικος, ἢ, ὄν Carian

Κόλχος ὁ Colchian  
Μελιττενός ὁ; Μελιττενή ἢ Milesian  
Ἰλλυριός Illyrian  
Σκύθης Scythian  
Λυδὴ ἢ Lydian
