1. *Fui, fuisti*, etc., are sometimes used instead of *sum, es*, etc.; so also *fueram* instead of *eram* and *fuero* instead of *ero*. Similarly, in the Perfect and Pluperfect Subjunctive *fuerm, fueris*, etc. are sometimes used instead of *sim, sis*, etc., and *fuissem* instead of *essem*.
