1. **Fui, fuisti**, etc., are sometimes used instead of **sum, es**, etc.; so also **fueram** instead of **eram** and **fuero** instead of **ero**. Similarly, in the Perfect and Pluperfect Subjunctive **fuirim, fueris**, etc. are sometimes used instead of **sim, sis**, etc., and **fuissem** instead of **essem**.
