circiter: near, not far from

colloquium -ī n.: conversation

cōnflīgō -flīgere -flīxī -flīctum: clash, fight*

congrēdiō -grēdī -gressus: come together, meet, join battle*

contrahō -trahere -trāxī -tractum: draw together, assemble, muster

effugiō -fugere -fūgī -fugitum: escape

excēdō -cēdere -cessī -cessum: leave, withdraw

exhauriō -haurīre -hausī -haustum: exhaust, deplete

facultās facultātis f.: willingness, readiness

Hadrūmētum -ī n.: Hadrumetum (city in north Africa, near Carthage)*

impraesentiārum: at present

incrēdibilis incrēdibile: unbelievable, incredible

īnsidiōr īnsidiārī īnsidiātus sum: ambush, lay a trap (+dat.)

invictus -a -um: undefeated

Numida -ae m.: Numidian (a tribe in northern Africa)

opprimō -primere -pressī -pressum: crush, overpower*

Padus -ī m.: Padus River (major river in northern Italy; modern Po)*

passus passūs m.: step, pace *or* five feet

Publius -ī m.: Publius*

Rhodanus -ī m.: Rhodanus River (major river in southern Gaul; modern Rhône) *

Scīpiō Scīpiōnis m.: Scipio*

Trebia -ae f.: Trebia (river in Cisalpine Gaul; tributary of the Po)*

trecentī -ae -a: three hundred

valēns valentis: strong, powerful

Zama -ae f.: Zama (town southwest of Carthage)*
