1. In **ēs** etc. the **e** is long. In the corresponding forms of **sum**, **e** is short. The difference in quantity between **ēdō** and **ēs** etc. depends upon inherited vowel variation (§ 17.a).
2. Old forms are **ēssūrus** and Supine **ēssum**.
